The Syllabus of BNYS has been designed to give equal onus in yogic science and other naturopathy techniques along with the human body and ailment study. For a basic understanding of the BNYS syllabus, it can be split into four quarters.

The first quarter, usually of 18 months focuses on providing knowledge on human anatomy and theoretical studies of Human physiotherapy and other ailments. The second quarter focuses on the microbiological and pathology studies. The third quarter emancipates on various therapeutic methods along with medical studies and the final quarter deals with the application of naturopathy studies in practical applications and scenarios in healing. Certain Universities follow a different course pattern where the curriculum is split into 3, each of 18 months duration. At the end of this course, the students are subjected to a one-year practical internship which will provide them real-time practical knowledge on the subject.
